Additional Notes

- Parents may drop off as early as 7:00 AM and pick up as late as 6:00 PM. Students are not required to stay from 7:00 AM-6:00 PM. Late fees will be incurred if campers are picked up after 6:00 PM.
- Parents are encouraged to drop off no later than 9:00 AM so that campers can participate in all activities provided.
- Parents may either pack lunch or order hot lunch through My Green Lunch.
- Afternoon classes will take place in "clubhouses", which are groups that are divided by grade completed.

Additional Notes

- **Parents must notify the school by the before Monday in order to attend the field trip.** This is necessary for transportation and ordering of tickets
- **The field trip permission form must be completed, signed and turned in before your student may go on a field trip**
- **Field trip shirts must be worn at all times on each of the field trips (including water attractions) for safety reasons.** Students may not attend the field trip without their field trip shirt. Shirts are included with tuition and may be picked up on your child's first day of camp.
- **On Mondays, lunch will be provided by CCS.** Further information on how lunch will be provided will be given in your acceptance packet.
- Field trip transportation is provided through the local public school transportation department. Travel will be by buses with certified drivers
- Specific field trip information will be provided once you are enrolled including: dates, locations, proper attire, departure and arrival times.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Application Fee:
\$95 for CCS Students, \$150 for Non-CCS

Option 1 - Membership

\$3,801 for the entire summer

Memberships are billed over three (3) equal installments starting in June. *The best option for families planning on attending most of the summer.*

Memberships are not refundable or transferable.

Option 2 - Weekly

\$508 per week

Weeks must be pre-selected. Weeks may be changed depending on availability. The best option for families planning on attending certain weeks of the summer. The total will be billed in June.

This plan is non-refundable.

Option 3 - Daily

\$123 per day

Families may purchase between 1 - 20 days (maximum of 20). This is the best option for families planning on attending only a few days of the Summer. The total will be billed in June.

This plan is non-refundable.
