

# School Preparedness Plan to Meet County Guidance for COVID-19

## Visitor Information

(POST ON WEBSITE AND AT ALL SCHOOL ENTRANCES)

### VISITORS/VOLUNTEERS

**The school allows only necessary visitors and volunteers on the campus and will limit the number of students and staff who come into contact with them.**

### FACE COVERINGS - We will support students and staff wearing masks by:

Grades K-5 students will wear masks at all times, except when eating or exercising.

Junior High students (grades 6-8) will wear masks at all times, except when eating or exercising.

Teachers /Staff will wear masks at all times, except when eating.

### PHYSICAL DISTANCING - We will support physical distancing by:

Teachers will be separated from students via a 6ft. radius using visual cues, such as a taped off area around the teacher's desk or at the front of the room.

Recess and lunch times have been restructured to accommodate distancing between cohorts during transition/play.

Junior High rooms have been configured to allow a 6ft. social distance space between student workspaces.

### CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

#### We will support cleaning and maintenance of our campus by:

- o Janitorial services disinfect all hard surfaces and restrooms each evening and classrooms will be sprayed with Vital Oxide nightly.
- o Dedicated maintenance disinfects restrooms and high-touch surfaces (doorknobs, hand railings, and light switches, etc.) with Clorox Wipes three additional times during each school day to maintain clean facilities.

- o Playgrounds and outdoor tables are sanitized with Vital Oxide between each use.

#### HYGIENE - We will support routine and frequent handwashing by:

- o Each classroom will have hand sanitizer available for student use throughout the day.

- o Each classroom will have a spray bottle of Vital Oxide to disinfect shared items or surfaces throughout the day.

- o Students will be required to wash their hands at the beginning of each day, before and after recesses and lunchtimes, and at the end of the day before leaving the school building.

Hand sanitizer stations are available throughout the facility for students/staff.

#### ROUTINE TESTING - We will encourage and support staff testing by:

Campbell Christian School offers employees onsite COVID-19 testing on a monthly basis - provided by PMH Laboratory Inc.

- Families are required to report known cases of COVID-19 in their household to the school immediately. The school will report all known COVID-19 cases to Santa Clara Public Health.
